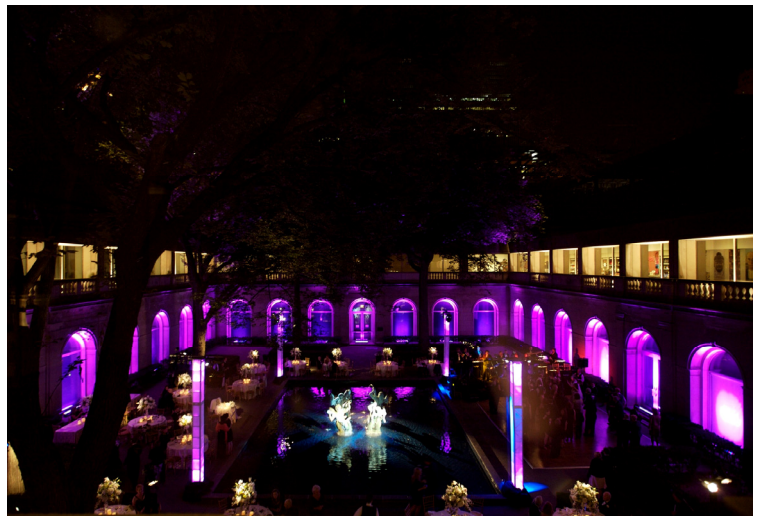
Challenges

- Coordinate setup and rehearsal times with the public hours of the museum.
- Light entire 100' x 100' courtyard with color changing LED lights with only limited power.
- Pinpoint tables and light dance floor which spanned throughout entire courtyard area.



Design

- (22) CK Colorblaze 48 LED fixtures were used to illuminate surrounding arches.
- (4) 15' tall truss towers constructed on the corners of the fountain to pinpoint tables and light dance floor.
- Conventional lighting fixtures which changed the color and texture of pool throughout evening.



Production

Although the production schedule presented many challenges, the lighting design and implementation of the pre-production plan was flawless. The LED lights used to highlight the arches accentuated the architecture of the museum while the color changing truss towers supported conventional and intelligent lighting fixtures that illuminated several elements throughout the space.

The end result was an unforgettable lighting experience in one of Chicago's most unique venues.
